

Foundation Year is an innovative first-year college program for students from Boston.

The program integrates a rigorous first-year curriculum with academic resources to create an environment where students can thrive and seamlessly transition to college. Students who successfully complete Foundation Year's academic progression standards can continue their degree in one of Northeastern University's undergraduate colleges or the College of Professional Studies.

Program Format

Foundation Year is a three-semester program that allows students to take transferable academic core credits during the fall, spring, and summer 1 terms of their first year. Students receive various resources and materials during the program to maximize their academic and student experience.

Eligibility

- Be a Boston resident for at least one year before applying.
- Graduate from a Boston public charter, private, or METCO school.
- Complete the HiSET® exam or obtain a GED.
- Meet Northeastern's selective admissions criteria.

As a Foundation Year student, you'll take courses that meet core, majorspecific, and elective requirements at Northeastern. These credits are eligible for transfer if you continue your degree at Northeastern.

After successfully completing Foundation Year, you can continue your degree at one of the seven undergraduate colleges at Northeastern's Boston campus or pursue a degree in our College of Professional Studies. Students who do not meet the academic progression standards—or prefer not to continue at Northeastern—may apply to transfer to external institutions.

How To Apply

Apply to Northeastern by the January 1 application deadline using the Common Application or Coalition Application. Students eligible for the Foundation Year program may nominate themselves within their Application Status Check portal or be nominated by a school professional or community member.
